**D**o you not have the skills needed to qualify or maybe you don't have a high school diploma or GED needed to attend training or school?

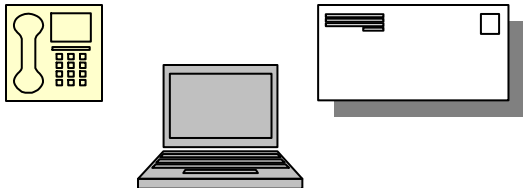
**E**very one is different, so maybe you're interested in something more challenging like pursuing a 2 or 4 year degree at an accredited college.

## Eligibility Requirements

- \* Training applicants must be an enrolled tribal member that resides in one of the AVCP federally recognized Tribes.
- \* Higher Education applicants must be enrolled in an AVCP compact tribe but, do not to reside in the community or region.
- \* Training applicants from Non-Compact Tribes are required to first seek assistance from their Tribe.
- \* All men must be in compliance with the Military Selective Service System Act.
- \* Income guidelines for some programs.
- \* Training applications must be received at least **two months** prior to the start of your training date.
- \* Higher Education applications must be received by **April 30** for the summer semester, **June 30** for the fall semester and **November 30** for the spring semester.
- \* Applications must be fully complete with required copies of documentation.
- \* Applicants are required to apply for FAFSA and to seek other funding sources.
- \* You must be able to demonstrate you have a financial **UNMET** need in order to be eligible for funding assistance.
- \* Child Care has its own requirements.
- \* Additional requirements may be necessary for other program services.
