Mandate #4

THIS MANDATE SUPERCEDES LOCAL MANDATE DATED MAY 7, 2020 AND WILL BE RE-EVALUATED ON JUNE 4, 2020.

EMERGENCY ORDERS TO PROTECT THE HEALTH AND SAFETY OF THE RESIDENTS OF QUINHAGAK, ALASKA DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

The Native Village of Kwinhagak IRA Council (NVK) met to establish protocol effective <u>March 23, 2020</u> (<u>Updated April 7, 2020</u>) (<u>Updated May 7, 2020</u>) (<u>Updated May 20, 2020</u>) until <u>June 15</u>, 2020 to ensure the health and safety of the residents of Quinhagak, Alaska during the COVID-19 pandemic and have established to following mandates:

- 1. Travel by non-Alaskan residents into Quinhagak, Alaska is suspended until **June 15**, 2020.
- 2. Local residents must show Quinhagak, AK as their primary residence on their State/Tribal identification card to travel by air to Quinhagak. Otherwise, non-residents traveling by air to Quinhagak will be required to get a written permission from Native Village of Kwinhagak.
- 3. Individuals traveling to Quinhagak from/through Anchorage, AK will be required to follow a 14-day self-quarantine, as well as all members of the household where he/she resides.
- 4. Residents will follow the guidelines for COVID-19 issued by this Local Emergency Order, the State of Alaska and the United States Government.
- 5. All residents will honor the safety measures implemented by all organizations.

The Native Village of Kwinhagak IRA Council-puts the health and safety of its community residents as a priority above all else and desires to put precautions in place to prevent the entry and transmission of the COVID-19.

The Native Village of Kwinhagak IRA Council-will put a priority on enforcement of this mandate to prevent the transmission of COVID-19 and failure to abide by the local, state and federal guidelines may result in criminal charges and fines.
