Description of Home or Address:

Homeowner _____ (NAME) agrees to allow the National Guard, the Department of Forestry, or another volunteer organization to “muck-out” their home including removal of any wet insulation and other water damaged material. The home will be left to dry out for a time and then, if the State of Alaska purchased the materials, AVCP, AVCP RHA, or other volunteer labor under AVCP or AVCP RHA’s supervision, will come back and install new insulation, Tyvek, and plywood to seal up the home. In addition, if it is determined that there is roofing damage that can easily be repaired, that work will be done as well, as well as stairs and landings as needed. The goal of this work is to reduce further damage to the home from water due to wet insulation or holes in the roof, so that it can be further repaired and habitable again.

The National Guard, the Department of Forestry, AVCP and AVCP RHA CANNOT guarantee that this work will not result in further damage to the home due to home’s current condition. Additionally, the home will not be returned to its original state, but rather prepared for winter, and a second stage of work that the homeowner will be responsible for.

The materials for this work will be supplied at no cost to the homeowner, and AVCP or AVCP RHA will perform labor to a generally accepted standard of performance in material and work.
